We will observe All Saints Day on Monday Oct. 31<sup>st</sup> at 3:30 and on Tuesday November 1<sup>st</sup> at 12:00 noon, and 6:00 pm. here at St. John. This is a time in which we rejoice for all the men and women who are in the presence of Almighty God. We give thanks and praise for all those who are with God as they pray for us to one day join them. This flows from our understanding of the doctrine of the Communion of Saints where all of the living are linked to those who have died, currently in the process of being purified and to those who are in Heaven already in God's presence.
