My dear friends in Christ,

This past Friday, February 3rd, was the feast of St. Blaisé. He was martyred in the persecution of the Roman Emperor Licinius during the early 4th Century. St. Blaisé was the Bishop of Sebaste in Armenia. He is associated with the healing of throats. I will offer the traditional blessing to each person of the parish after the weekend Masses using this blessing:

Through the intersession of St. Blaise, bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from every disease of the throat and from every other illness:

In the name of the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

It was suggested by several parishioners that we have columns upon which to place the angels on each side of the High Altar. With that in mind, Weberding Carving was contacted, and they made the new columns to match the beauty of the High Altar. This was funded by generous donors for whom I am most grateful.
