

Today is Rose Sunday -the Fourth Sunday of Lent, traditionally known as *Laetare* "Rejoice" Sunday. We give thanks this special day as the priest wears rose-colored vestments to remind us that Easter is approaching. It is good at this time to review and renew our Lenten resolutions to prepare us for the celebration of our Lord's Resurrection.

You will notice a slight change to the Lenten schedule for this week. On Sunday, we will have the Way of the Cross at 1:00 p.m. We will also have Mass on Wednesday, March 13th at 9:00 a.m.

Next weekend we will have the Anointing of the Sick at each Mass. Also, next Sunday, March 17th, our Way of the Cross will be at 1:00 p.m. When we pray the Stations of the Cross we are reminded of the tremendous love our Lord Jesus has for us which is reflected in the Holy Eucharist. Please join us Friday/Sunday for the Way of the Cross. It only takes 30 minutes. I look forward to seeing you!

The Chrism Mass will be celebrated on Tuesday, March 26th, 5:30 PM CDT, at St. Benedict Cathedral. At this Mass, the holy oils used throughout the year are blessed and consecrated by Bishop Siegel. The priests of the diocese make a public renewal of their priestly promises to serve Christ and the Church. The Sacrament of Reconciliation will also be available prior to the Mass. All are invited to attend and pray together as a diocese.
