2. Sincerely repent of all our sins;
3. Place our complete trust in Jesus;
4. Go to Confession, (Father is having confession Saturday (1:30 to 3:30) and Sunday Apr. 24th after the 4:00 Mass.)
5. Receive Holy Communion or make a Spiritual Communion on the day of the Feast;
6. Venerate (bow to) the Image of the Divine Mercy;
7. Be merciful to others, through our actions, words, and prayers on their behalf.

Act of Contrition

My God, I am sorry for my sins with all my heart. In choosing to do wrong and failing to do good, I have sinned against you whom I should love above all things.
