From Our Pastor

My dear friends in Christ,

This weekend we will have the parish Rogation prayers at the weekend Masses. Mindful of God's care for His people and His creation, we ask for God's blessing on our tools, fields, flocks, seeds and those who will work with them. We say a prayer of thanksgiving for the farmers of our parish asking the Lord Jesus to keep them safe and prosperous during this year. We asked the children to bring a packet of seeds for the blessing.

After a number of months of our bells not working, we had them evaluated by Verdin Bell Company and a second evaluation by JJ. Smith & Company. The recommendation given by both companies was that our carillon system needs to be replaced as there are no longer parts to fix a system which is over 30 years old.

To address this situation, I formed a committee with Rick Bowling as chair person, Van McAtee, Tom McAtee, Annette Taylor, Deacon Consley, Dr. Rick Bower, Cam Ackerman and Vicki Strange. As you know, Rick Bowling has a great interest in the history of our area including the origin of the bells of Martin County. He photographed both of our bells and summited a short history. The current carillon system was installed over 30 years ago. At that time, the striker on one of the bells was discontinued. The committee heard presentations from the Verdin Company as well as the JJ. Smith. It was the committee's recommendation to go with the JJ. Smith Company. After consultation with JJ Smith it was decided that a striker be installed on both of the two bells as well as to install a new carillon system and speakers.

I had Rick Bowling and Van McAtee give a presentation to the Parish Council regarding their findings and recommendation. As a result, the Parish Council reached a consensus that we give the contract to the JJ Shortly after the council Smith Company.

meeting, Rick Bowling approached me and said that he wanted to donate the full amount in honor of his father and mother, Bill and Ardis Bowling, and his brother, Pat Bowling. He has paid the full amount to the parish for which we are most grateful.
