From Our Pastor

My dear friends in Christ,

Today, we celebrate the feast of the most Holy Trinity in which we honor God the Father, Jesus, His Son, and the Holy Spirit, all united in one God, now revealed in salvation history. We give thanks for the divine qualities which have been revealed about our Triune God: mercy, fidelity, love, grace, and fellowship, as we bow before the Holy Trinity. God reveals the importance of being in relationship with others, as the Trinity itself, is a relationship. We believe that God's love and message is for all people in all times. It extends to people who live far away from us, to those who have lived before us, and to those who will come after us.

On Sunday, June 19th we will celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (*Corpus Christi*). The Holy Eucharist is the source and summit of our faith from which we are nourished by our Lord Jesus. All of our good works and charity flow from our belief in the Holy Eucharist as the center of our faith. The *Corpus Christi* procession is a wonderful example to the community of our belief in the Holy Eucharist as the center of our life. After the 10:00 Mass we will have a *Corpus Christi* procession. The procession will leave from Church - travel along Church Street and stop at 4 different stations representing north, south, east, and west. Our Choir members will help lead the singing. Children are welcome to come and walk with us and throw flower petals. (Please bring your own basket). For those who are unable to walk with us, golf carts are welcome and some may be available for your use. You are invited to drive to any of the 4 stations. I encourage you to participate in this public display of our belief in the Holy Eucharist as the Body & Blood of our Lord Jesus and the center of our Catholic faith.

Month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus
Devotion of the Month

Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is one of the most popular Catholic devotions. Although it was beloved in previous centuries, Jesus appeared to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in 1673, showing her a vision of the now-famous image of His Sacred Heart, surrounded by flames. He said to her: "My Heart is so full of love for men that It can no longer contain the flames of Its burning love. I must discover to men the treasures of My Heart and save them from perdition." She was given the special mission to spread devotion to His Sacred Heart throughout the Church. Jesus gave St. Margaret Mary many promises associated with this devotion, and requested that a feast day in honor of His Sacred Heart be instituted on the Friday after the Octave of Corpus Christi. In 1856, the Feast of the Sacred Heart was spread to the Universal Church, and in 1899 Pope Leo XIII solemnly consecrated all mankind to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, calling it "the great act" of his pontificate.
