### My dear friends in Christ,

This weekend we welcome **Rev. Tom Vermiglio** of the Comboni Missionaries to our parish to participate in the Annual Missionary Cooperation Plan. Father Tom Vermiglio will preach at all the Masses and will make an appeal. Fr. Tom was ordained a Comboni Missionary Priest 35 years ago. The first five years of his priesthood he worked in East Africa, teaching secondary school and doing parish ministry. For the next 13 years he worked in the U.S. and Canada doing vocation and mission promotion. In 1990 he returned to Kenya for three more years of parish ministry, in the slum area of Nairobi Kenya. From 1993 until 2006 Fr. Tom did mission promotion and parish work again in the U.S. and Canada. The Comboni Missionaries need our prayers and financial support for their ministry.
