#### My dear friends in Christ,

We will have religion class today for those students in the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grades. We pray that the Holy Spirit will continue to guide and direct us as we seek to impart our treasured faith.

#### September is the Month of Our Lady of Sorrows (Mater Dolorosa)

The Church dedicates the month of September to Our Lady of Sorrows, also known as Mater Dolorosa (Mother of Sorrows). This devotion recalls the Blessed Virgin Mary's spiritual martyrdom in virtue of her perfect union with the Passion of Christ. This was her role in salvation history, and what merited her place as the spiritual Mother of all Christians. This is symbolized by a single sword, or seven swords, piercing Mary's suffering heart, as foretold in Simeon's prophecy. Traditionally the Church meditates on the "Seven Sorrows' of our Blessed Mother:

- 1. the prophecy of Simeon;
- 2. the Holy Family's flight into Egypt;
- 3. the loss of the Child Jesus for three days;
- 4. the meeting of Mary and Jesus as he carried his cross;
- 5. Jesus' crucifixion and death;
- 6. Jesus' sacred body taken down from the cross;
- 7. and Jesus' burial.

# The feast of Our Lady of Sorrows (Mater Dolorosa) is September 15<sup>th</sup>.
