From Our Pastor

My dear friends in Christ,

Wednesday of this week is Ash Wednesday which begins the season of Lent. During this time we try to unite ourselves closer with our Lord Jesus as we journey toward his passion, death, and Resurrection. We are to keep in mind that the Lord Jesus never ceases to have mercy on us, and desires to offer us his forgiveness when we are sorry. Jesus invites us to return to him with a new heart, purified from evil, so as to take part in his Resurrected joy.

Our Mass schedule for Ash Wednesday will be at 8:15 am., 12:00 Noon, and 7:00 pm. Ashes will be blessed and distributed after the homily at each Mass. Let us use this time of Lent to grow closer to our Lord.

Ash Wednesday is a day of fast and abstinence. Abstinence means we do not eat meat. Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all the Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence. The obligation to abstain on the appointed days begins the day after your fourteenth birthday.

Fasting means that we eat only one full meal on the fast day. Two other light meals are permitted,

but eating between meals is not permitted. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days when we are obliged to fast. You are obliged to observe the fast from the day after your eighteenth birthday until the day after you fifty-ninth birthday.

Friday is the Church's day of penance in memory of Jesus' passion. Some form of penance is especially encouraged on each Friday throughout the year.

Pregnant women and people who are sick are not obliged to fast. Others who feel they are unable to observe the laws of fast and abstinence should consult a parish priest or confessor.-(from the Handbook for Today's Catholic)
