## From Our Pastor

My dear friends in Christ,

Happy Easter!! Today is a day of glory and a day of hope for us all. We celebrate the good news that the tomb was empty and that our Lord Jesus rose from the dead. Let us surrender our hearts and wills to our loving God, who offers us new life on earth and in Heaven. We now rejoice that Jesus has opened the gates of Heaven for all who believe and who allows us to share in His peace throughout our earthly journey.

Every parish has its source of income from the weekly collections, whereas the diocese receives its funding to operate from the Catholic Parish Campaign. Many wonderful services are provided to us from the CPC which are administered through the Catholic Center. The bill for our parish this year is **\$154,968.00** and we ask each family to contribute **\$352.20** which is based on the number of those who gave \$50 or more last year to the parish (440), divided into the total amount. All checks are to be made payable to the Catholic Parish Campaign. *Any funds that are raised over and beyond the required amount will stay in the parish.* I appreciate very much your ongoing support and generosity.

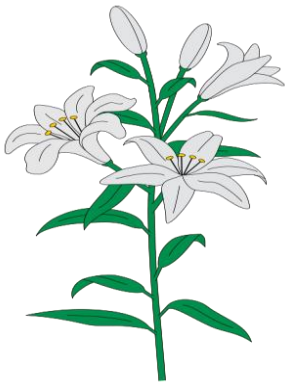

The three days are interspersed with music, sharing, laughter, prayer, reflection and silence as you discover what



it means to say, "We are the body of Christ." Mass is celebrated each day (except Thursday) as well as morning and evening prayers. There is nothing dull about a Cursillo weekend. 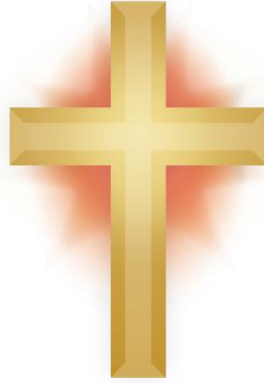
