### **My dear friends in Christ,**

This weekend we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday. John Paul II said at the canonization of St. Faustina, **"by this act today, I pass on the message of Divine Mercy to the new millennium."** He said that in the future, the Sunday after Easter would be known throughout the world as Divine Mercy Sunday, and that priests and the laity should take advantage of this special grace.

The remarkable grace of the Feast of Mercy is very much like the grace of Baptism. The sacramental grace of Baptism received by an adult is not only the removal of original sin but is also the forgiveness of all personal sins and any punishment due to them. So the soul cleansed on the Feast of Mercy is like the soul of one newly baptized.

A special thank-you to all those who made the Holy Week and Easter Masses so prayerful. We continue to enjoy the beautiful flowers and decorations which were done by Peggy Lyon, Donna Graber along with the help of Nancy Smith. 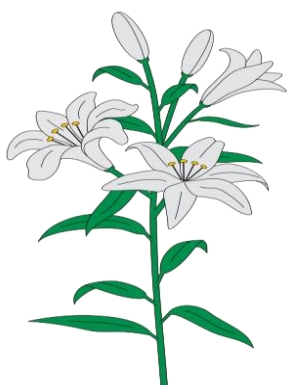

Fifteen talks are given, ten by laypersons and five by the spiritual directors. The talks lead to lively discussions in small groups. The three days are interspersed with music, sharing, laughter, prayer, reflection and silence as you discover what



it means to say, "We are the body of Christ." Mass is celebrated each day (except Thursday) as well as morning and evening prayers. There is nothing dull about a Cursillo weekend. It is a joyous workshop in the fundamentals of our encounter with Jesus Christ. They next Cursillo weekends available are Men-Oct. 5-8 and Women-Nov. 2-5. 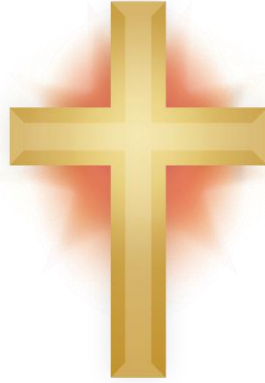
