Due to the virus that is circulating at this time, we have been advised to only receive the sacred host at Communion. Also, at the sign of peace it has been suggested that we not shake hands with one another. Rather, we are encouraged to give some gesture which expresses our Lord's peace to one another. This is done right before we received the Blessed Sacrament-- the sign of unity among us as Roman Catholics. In addition, we have placed hand sanitizers at the entrances of the church.

For your planning, once again the diocese will be observing "The Light Is On" Wednesday March 11th from 6:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. This is an opportunity to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation. At this time throughout the diocese at each designated church we will have the opportunity to receive the Sacrament of Penance. This year it will be at St. Martin Church in Whitfield for our parish.

This Sunday, is Sanctity for Life Weekend in anticipation of the anniversary of Roe vs. Wade which legalized abortion in the United States on January 22, 1973. May our prayers overturn this terrible legislation and once again institute a culture that values life at all stages, from conception to natural death.

Archabbot Kurt Stasiak, O.S.B., asked that I speak to you this weekend about Saint Meinrad Archabbey and Seminary since I am a graduate of the St. Meinrad College and the School of Theology.
