During Lent our Parish Rosary will be after the 8:00 Mass on Sunday. This is another opportunity for us to honor the Blessed Mother as we reflect on our Lord's life, death, and Resurrection and the important role of the Blessed Mother as she was open to God's will.

In the words of St. John the Baptist we are call to decrease so that the Lord Jesus may increase in our lives.

During Lent we are called to Abstinence which means we do not eat meat. All the Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence. The obligation to abstain on the appointed days begins the day after your fourteenth birthday.

For your planning, once again the diocese will be observing "The Light Is On" Wednesday March 11<sup>th</sup> from 6:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. This is an opportunity to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation. At this time throughout the diocese at each designated

church we will have the opportunity to receive the Sacrament of Penance. This year it will be at St. Martin Church in Whitfield for our parish.
