I would like to extend a Happy Mother's Day to all the mothers, grandmothers, aunts and special ladies within the parish. You are a tremendous gift and please know that you are in my prayers!

This Sunday is our parish May Crowning at the 10:00 a.m. Mass. The May Crowning encourages all of us to have great devotion to our Blessed Mother.

We believe that our Lord gave the Blessed Mother to the Church when he said to St. John, "Behold your Mother." It has been a constant teaching of our faith that the Blessed Mother intercedes for us, always pointing us toward fidelity to her Son. Mary seat of wisdom, pray for us!

Starting May 18th we will begin our public liturgies here at St. John and throughout the diocese. The dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days will continue until at least Aug. 15, 2020.

The public liturgies for us include: funerals, weddings and week-day Masses in St. John Church.

Our weekend Masses will start May 23rd & 24th which will be celebrated in the

lower level of the parish Center. We are required to maintain social distancing of 6 feet apart. Utilizing the Center we can properly sanitize the area after each service and maintain the social distance. I will be having an additional Mass on Sundays at 4:00 p.m.

We need to continue to strongly encourage parishioners 65 and older, and those with underlying medical issues, to stay home and participate in our online livestream Masses

The livestreaming is a wonderful way for me to come into your homes to celebrate the sacred mysteries with you.
