From Our Pastor,

Today, we celebrate the feast of the most Holy Trinity in which we honor God the Father, Jesus, His Son, and the Holy Spirit, all united in one God, now revealed in salvation history. We give thanks for the divine qualities which have been revealed about our Triune God: mercy, fidelity, love, grace, and fellowship, as we bow before the Holy Trinity. God reveals the importance of being in relationship with others, as the Trinity itself, is a relationship. We believe that God's love and message is for all people in all times. It extends to people who live far away from us, to those who have lived before us, and to those who will come after us.

Next Sunday we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (*Corpus Christi*). The Holy Eucharist is the source and summit of our faith from which we are nourished by our Lord Jesus. All of our good works and charity flow from our belief in the Holy Eucharist as the center of our faith. The *Corpus Christi* Procession is a wonderful example to the community of our belief in the Holy Eucharist as the center of our life. After the 10:00 Mass we will have a *Corpus Christi* Procession. I encourage you to participate in this public demonstration of our belief in the Holy Eucharist as the Body & Blood of our Lord Jesus and the center of our faith.

Funerals, weddings and week-day Masses are celebrated in St. John Church, as usual. **On weekends, the Holy Mass is celebrated in the lower level of the parish Center.** We are required to maintain social distancing of 6 feet apart. Utilizing the Center we can properly sanitize the area after each service and maintain the social distance. I will be having an additional Mass on Sundays at 4:00 p.m.

A mask is highly suggested when you attend Mass. Those age 7 and older are asked to wear a mask from the time you exit your vehicle until you return.

Please bring your personal hand

sanitizer. We suggest you use it when you are seated, prior to communion, immediately after communion, and as you return to your vehicle.

The dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days continues until at least Aug. 15, 2020. Therefore, no one is required to return to Mass if they are uncomfortable.

Parishioners 65 and older, and those with underlying medical issues, are encouraged to stay home and participate in our online livestream Masses. However, the final decision is left to you.
