The following are some of the improvements currently under way in the parish:

The contracts for the new heating and air conditioning systems for the Church and Center were issued to Mesmer Mechanical for \$139,000.00. This price includes both buildings. Installation is scheduled to begin in August starting with the church boiler replacement followed by replacement of the air conditioning systems with digital Wi-Fi capable controls in both Church and Center.

Our new sound system for the church was issued to SolTek Audio & Video Solutions for \$46,768.00. Installation is expected to soon take place.

The seal and stripe bids for the west parking lot are being submitted by three contractors. We anticipate the contract to be awarded in August, with the work taking place this fall.

All of above facility improvements are being paid in full with our parish's share of the **Capital Campaign Funds**.
