From Our Pastor,

After some time of deliberation it has been recommended and backed by our parish council to begin the process of removing the stained glass windows from St. Mary Barr Township Chapel. This is being done because the windows are being damaged from the settling of the church. Some of the stained glass are showing cracking at the edges and warping which necessitate action at this time. The stained glass windows are very beautiful, valuable and have been given by various ancestors of our community.

With a view to preserve these artifacts and our history, Mominee Studios have been retained to remove the windows, make wooden frames with LED lights and then install them in the upper and lower level of St. John Parish Center. Mominee Studios Inc., Artists in Stained Glass are quite adept at this technique. If you remember, they are the company that put the protective glass on our outside storm windows at St. John Church and have an excellent reputation throughout our diocese and the state of Indiana. Mominee Studios will remove six to seven windows at a time, make the new window frames and install them at the parish Center before moving on to the next set of windows. As the stained glass is removed from St. Mary Chapel, it will be replaced with clear glass. The work has begun.

May the Lord bless and keep you, Father Walker.
