From Our Pastor,

Congratulations to Dr. Rick Bauer, Mary Gates, Lynn Gee, Krista Sims, and Sandy Woods who will be inducted into the Bruté Society. The Bruté Society was established by Bishop Gettelfinger in 1990, to honor lay persons for their outstanding stewardship. The Bruté Society is named for Servant of God, Bishop Simon Brute the first Bishop of Vincennes in 1834. At that time, the territory of the Vincennes Diocese included all of Indiana as well as about one third of Illinois. The name "The Bruté Society" represents the rich spiritual and historical heritage of the present Diocese of Evansville. We give thanks for the tremendous contributions that Dr. Rick Bauer, Mary Gates, Lynn Gee, Krista Sims, and Sandy Woods have made to the parish and our greater community!

The process of removing the stained glass windows from St. Mary Barr Township Chapel continues. Some of the stained glass showed cracking at the edges and warping which necessitates taking action. The stained glass windows are very beautiful, valuable and have been given by various ancestors of our community.

With a view to preserve these artifacts and our history, Mominee Studios are removing the windows, making wooden frames with LED lights and then will install them in the upper and lower levels of St. John Parish Center. Mominee Studios Inc., Artists in Stained Glass are quite adept at this technique. They will remove several windows at a time for the parish Center before moving on to the next set. As the stained glass is removed from St. Mary Chapel, it is replaced with clear glass.
