The online site will be available for sign-ups Tuesdays beginning at 8:00 AM until Fridays at 5:00 PM until Tuesday, March 31 at 5:00 PM. Online sign-up is easy and has an advantage. You will receive a FREE \$10.00 portrait coupon to use toward additional photos for your online appointment booking.

2. For six weeks beginning Saturday, Feb. 28 you may sign up after any weekend Mass on the sign-up sheets located on the tables in the back of church. Someone will be available after each Mass to assist you.

Once signed up you will receive reminders of your upcoming photography session a few days in advance of your appointment. These will come to you via a phone call, U.S. mail, or an email.

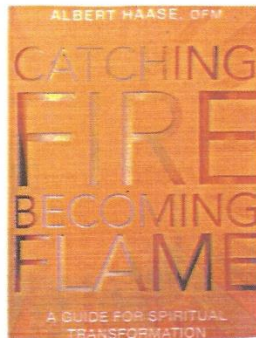
Is your spiritual life just smoldering?
