Clyde was the Sheriff of Martin County and highly involved in the political life of Martin County, our state and at times, our nation, having served on the National Democratic Committee. Clyde was a good husband, father, grandfather, brother, and friend. Logan Craney accomplished a lot in his short-lived life as he was a caring, compassionate, and kind young man who did his best to reach out to others, seeing God's presence. From the time Logan was in early grade school he loved his Catholic faith and church having been an altar server, master of ceremonies and helper of the church in every way that he could. Logan was a hard worker, as a farmer and a worker for National Gypsum who always went that extra mile. Whitey and Logan were both faithful members of our parish who will be greatly missed by us all. May they rest in peace. Amen.

Last Saturday our diocesan wide celebration at the Ford Center in Evansville was a success. Bishop Charles C. Thompson and the priests of the diocese celebrated this event entitled "**Rejoice! A Catholic Community Celebration.**" For me, it was wonderful to be with our Catholic family to Celebrate, Rejoice and be One at the Lord's table!
