From Our Pastor

My dear friends in Christ

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (*Corpus Christi*). The Holy Eucharist is the source and summit of our faith from which we are nourished by our Lord Jesus. All of our good works and charity flow from our belief in the Holy Eucharist as the center of our faith. Our Corpus Christi Procession today is a wonderful example to the community in our belief in the Holy Eucharist as the center in our life. After the 10:30 Mass we will have a Corpus Christi Procession. The procession will leave from Church, travel along Church Street and stop at 4 different stations before returning back to the church for Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. The 4 stations are located at: (1.) The corner of Church St. and 231, (2.) The town square, (3.) The intersection of North Street and Kentucky Ave., and (4) The church parking lot by the railroad tracks. For those who are unable to walk with us, golf carts are available or you are invited to drive to any of the 4 stations to pray and to watch the procession. I encourage you to participate in this public demonstration of our belief in the Holy Eucharist as the Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus and the center of our faith.

A significant dent has been made in our bill to the diocese for the Catholic Parish Campaign. We owe **\$157,142.00**, and have asked each family to contribute **\$350.00**. At this writing we have received **\$151,228.10** which means we still need **\$5,913.90**. All checks are to be made payable to the Catholic Parish Campaign. If you have not yet responded to this campaign I ask that you please do so, to keep us from paying the bill from the parish checking account.
