#### From Our Pastor

\_ My dear friends in Christ,

On Wednesday we celebrated the funeral Mass for William"Bill" Cox. Bill served in the Air Force, and after returning from the military spent most his working years at Crane, until his retirement. It was an honor to have had Bishop Thompson with us last Sunday as he celebrated the Sacrament of Confirmation for our 21 students. The day was a beautiful one and I certainly was very proud of our 9th graders as thev demonstrated a strong desire to receive the third sacrament of initiation and were well-prepared! A special thank you to their parents and sponsors, who have been and are an integral part of their faith journey. The fellowship committee hosted a wonderful reception following the Confirmation Mass for which I am most grateful. A note of appreciation to Darin and Jane Holder, who taught our Confirmation class this year and as well to our catechetical director, Paula Ringwald.
