From Our Pastor

My dear friends in Christ,

We celebrated the funeral Mass for Helen M. Fullerton this past Friday. We give thanks for her 93 years of life and the important impact she made on so many lives. Helen was a positive and up-lifting individual who always made others feel better after they talked to her. She will be greatly missed by her son and all of us. Let perpetual light shine upon her. May she rest in peace. Amen.

This Friday May 29th was the 34th anniversary of my Ordination to the Priesthood. I was ordained by Bishop Shea on a Friday evening here at St. John. My first Mass was celebrated also at St. John on Sunday, May 31st. Little did I know that I would one day return as Pastor of our newly formed St. John the Evangelist Parish. I have been very happy as a priest for these 34 years, but I must admit that since I have returned to Loogootee, this is the happiest time in my priesthood. I give thanks and praise for the opportunity to be here as your Pastor and ask the Lord to give me the grace to serve you well.

Unfortunately, some of you were missed when we sent out the original Catholic Parish Campaign letters. This has come to light from the better list we have compiled from the pictorial directory committee. I am sorry if you receive a second letter, but we are doing our very best to establish the most accurate list of our parishioners.

As you will see in the next paragraph, we are getting closer to reaching our goal and some of you have come forward with additional funds.

Our bill this year is **\$147,470.00**. We have asked each family to contribute **\$330.00**. At this writing we have received **\$142,255.00** which means we still need **\$5,215.00**. All checks are to be made payable to the Catholic Parish Campaign. If you have not responded to this campaign, I ask that you help us, so that we will not have to pay the bill from the parish checking account. **A special thank-you to those who have already responded to this important campaign. I appreciate very much your ongoing support and generosity!**
