From Our Pastor

My dear friends in Christ,

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (*Corpus Christi*). After the 10:30 Mass we will have a Corpus Christi Procession. The procession will leave from Church, travel along Church Street and stop at 4 different stations before returning back to the church for Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. The 4 stations are located at: (1.) The corner of Church St. and 231, (2.) The town square, (3.) The intersection of North Street and Kentucky Ave., and (4) The church parking lot by the railroad tracks. For those who are unable to walk with us, you are invited to join us at any of the 4 stations to pray and to watch the procession. I encourage you to participate in this public demonstration of our belief in the Holy Eucharist as the Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus and the center of our faith.

There is an insert in the bulletin regarding, "Marriage and the Supreme Court". The Supreme Court is now considering whether states can define marriage as the union of one man and one woman, and whether a state that does so must recognize a "marriage" contracted out-of-state by two persons of the same sex. The Bishops have encouraged Catholics to participate in a Call to Prayer for Life, Marriage, and Religious Liberty. We are asked to pray and fast for life, marriage, and religious liberty. The Bishops have also called for a Fortnight for Freedom from June 21-July 4 focusing on the Freedom to Bear Witness. To heighten our awareness as a parish, we will have a prayer service here at St. John on Sunday, June 28th at 2:00 pm.

WE ARE NOW VERY CLOSE TO REACHING OUR GOAL. Our bill this year is \$147,470.00. We have asked each family to contribute \$330.00. At this writing we have received **\$144,770.00** which means we still need **\$2,700.00**. All checks are to be made payable to the Catholic Parish Campaign. If you have not responded to this campaign, I ask that you help us, so that we will not have to pay the bill from the parish checking account. **A special thank-you to those who have already responded to this important campaign.
