My dear friends in Christ,

I am most happy and thankful to report to you that we have **REACHED OUR CPC GOAL OF \$147,470.00 through cash or pledges.** This is dependent on everyone following through on their initial commitment. **A special thank-you to all those who have responded to this important campaign. I appreciate very much your ongoing SUPPORT and GENEROSITY!**

Last Sunday, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (*Corpus Christi*) with a special procession after the 10:30 Mass. The procession left the church and traveled along Church Street and through-out the city. It stopped at four different stations which symbolized the four corners of the world. The procession returned to church for Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. The 3rd Degree Knights of Columbus held the canopy and flags, while the members of the 4th Degree of Knights of Columbus provided the Honor Guard. The parish servers and members of the youth group were fully involved. The music was led by the parish choir and music ministry team. This was a wonderful demonstration of our belief in the Holy Eucharist as the Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus and the center of our faith. A special thank-you to Paula Ringwald for all of her hard work and to all who participated.

We owe a debt of gratitude to Stephanie McAtee for the countless hours she gave as the Chairperson of our pictorial directory. There were a total of 455 portraits and 828 separate family address entries included. Notice from St. John Cemetery Association:

We are in the heart of the mowing season for the cemetery. Please be mindful when decorating gravesites of the necessity to have clear access to mow and trim around the gravestones. As a reminder the following rules outline in both the Cemetery Association By-Laws and the Plot Certificate issued to the purchasers apply:

1. Decorations may be attached to headstones by a saddle or set immediately adjacent to the base of a headstone in small metal or plastic (no glass!)vase. Shepard hooks for hanging baskets will be placed immediately adjacent to the marker base. Decorations that cannot be secured to or immediately adjacent to a headstone such as bric-a-brac, toy, bottles/cans. Plastic flower arrangements, stoneware, etc. are discouraged and may be removed by the cemetery committee without notice if deemed inappropriate to the dignity of the cemetery and/or interfering with mowing/trimming.
2. It is the responsibility of the gravesite owner(s) to assure that graves are properly marked and that all decorations comply with the provisions herein.
