Dr. Keller and the Loogootee School system have graciously offered the use of the Loogootee Elementary School for our religion program.

Therefore, on Wednesday after school from 3:30 to 4:30 we will be able to offer religious education to the students from our parish at the Loogootee Elementary School. The religious education teachers will go to the school to have class. Our students will already be at the school giving them every opportunity to attend. Adult leaders from the parish will accompany the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade students from the Junior High to the Loogootee Elementary School. At the end of class the parents will be able to pick up their children at 4:30. This is a great opportunity to insure that our students will be able to have their religion class.
