This year, All Saints Day, Nov. 1st, is a Holy Day but the obligation falls out because it is on the weekend. We will observe All Saints Day at the Vigil Mass on Friday, Oct. 31st, at 4:00 p.m. and on Saturday, Nov. 1st, at 12 (Noon), which is also a First Saturday Mass. This is a time in which we rejoice for all the men and women who are in the presence of Almighty God. We give thanks and praise for all those who are with God as they pray for us to one day join them. 
