This Friday, October 31st, we will have Trunk N Treat from 6:00 p.m. - 7:30 p.m. in the Lower Level of the Parish Center. I look forward to seeing you along with your family!

This year, All Saints Day, Nov. 1st, is a Holy Day but the obligation falls out because it is on the weekend. We will observe All Saints Day at the Vigil Mass on Friday, Oct. 31st, at 4:00 p.m. and on Saturday, Nov. 1st, at 12 (Noon), which is also a First Saturday Mass. This is a time in which we rejoice for all the men and women who are in the presence of Almighty God. We give thanks and praise for all those who are with God as they pray for us to one day join them. All of this flows from our understanding of the doctrine of the Communion of Saints where all of the living are linked to those who have died and are in need of prayers, and to those who presently are in the presence of God.

Then we will observe All Souls' Day at the Saturday, 5:00 p.m. Mass as well as each Mass on Sunday, Nov. 2nd. During November, we are called to remember our brothers and sisters who have fallen asleep in the hope of the Resurrection.
